Overview: READBowl begins on January 12, the week before the College Football National Championship Game - and culminates with the crowning of the World Reading Champions on Super Bowl Sunday

Registration: Adults must register their teams to participate https://www.readwithmalcolm.com/readbowl/

A team consists of at least 8 students and must be registered for one of the following **READBowl** Conferences:

- Primary Conference: PreK-2nd
- The Big Three Conference: 3rd
- Elementary Conference: 4th & 5th
- Middle Conference: 6th, 7th, 8th
- Jr Varsity Conference: 9th & 10th
- Varsity Conference: 11th & 12th
- World Cup Conference: International

Tracking Reading Minutes in the Weekly Playbook:

- Reading minutes will be tracked on-line in the Official **READBowl** Weekly Playbook by your child's teacher.
- You may assist your child in tracking their minutes read at home. Submission guidelines are up to your child's teacher.
- Students may begin tracking their reading minutes at 8:00 am EST each Monday of the competition and stop tracking student reading minutes at 11:59 pm EST each Sunday.
- Parents and Adults may provide guidance on reading materials and encourage students to choose age appropriate books within genres they enjoy.
- Any reading material and minutes count! Students can read at school, at home or on the go, and can read as much or little as they want on any given day. Reading minutes may include: Books, magazine articles, read Alouds, instructions and even recipes!

<u>The Game:</u> READBowl is held over 4 weeks. Each week is a quarter. Each quarter begins on Monday morning and runs through Sunday night. There is a special half time show between quarters 2 and 3.
