

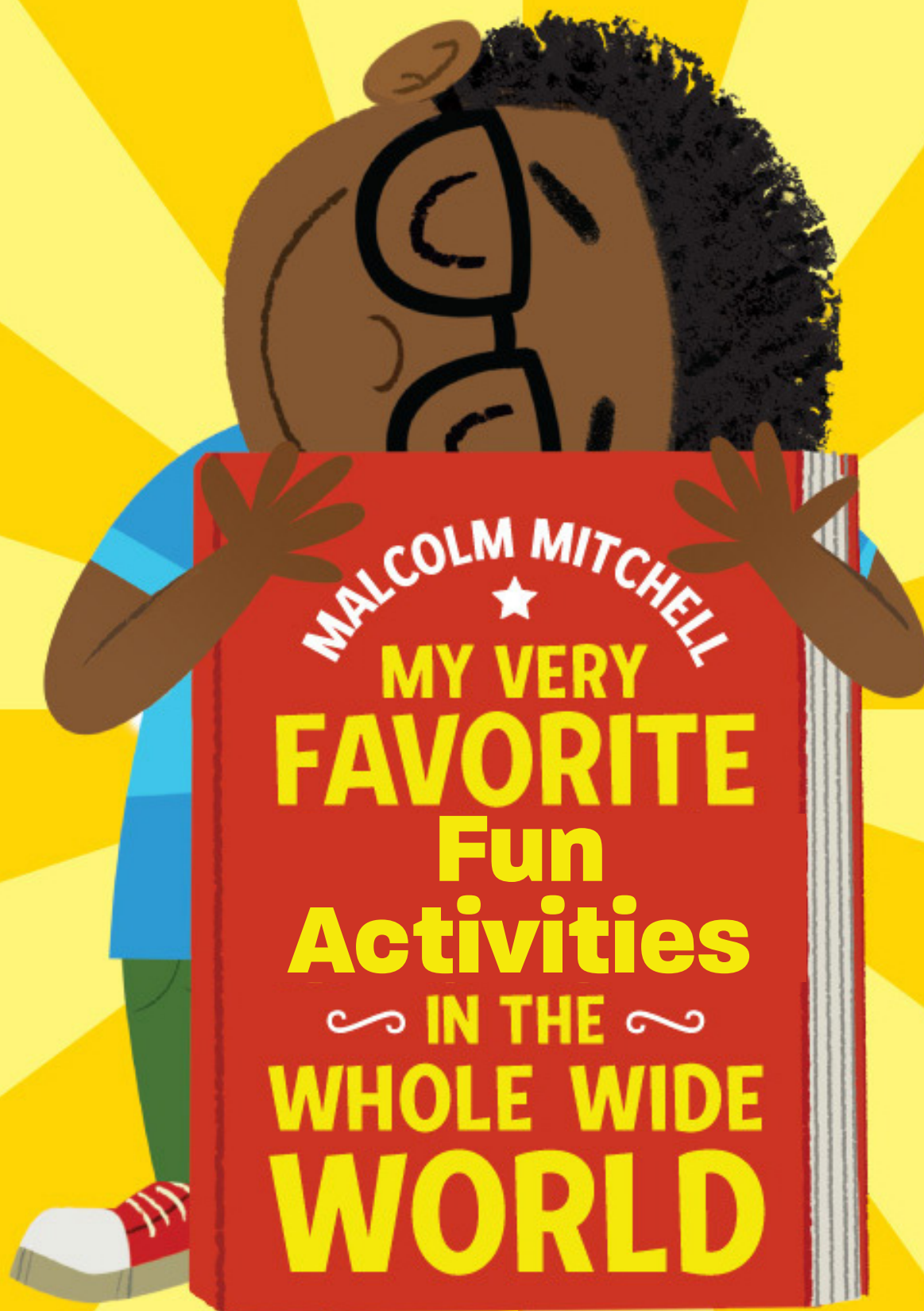

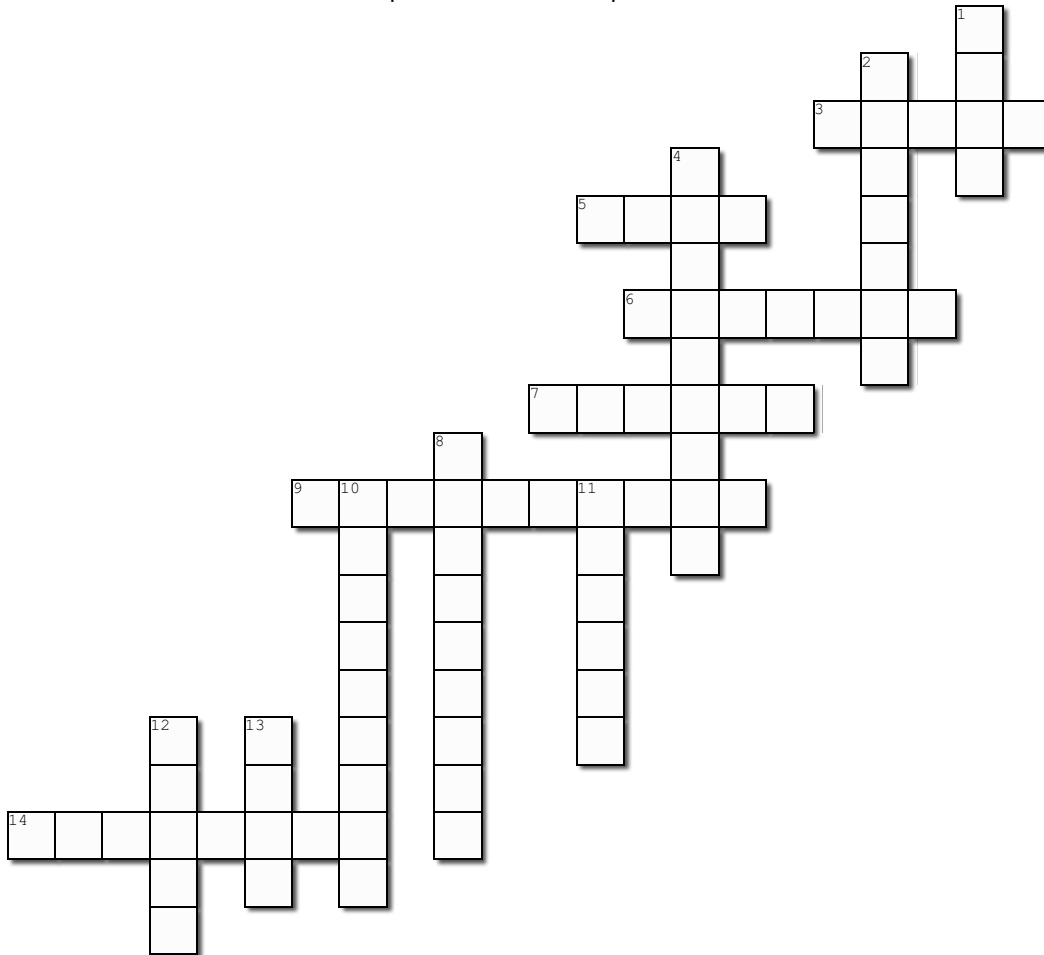

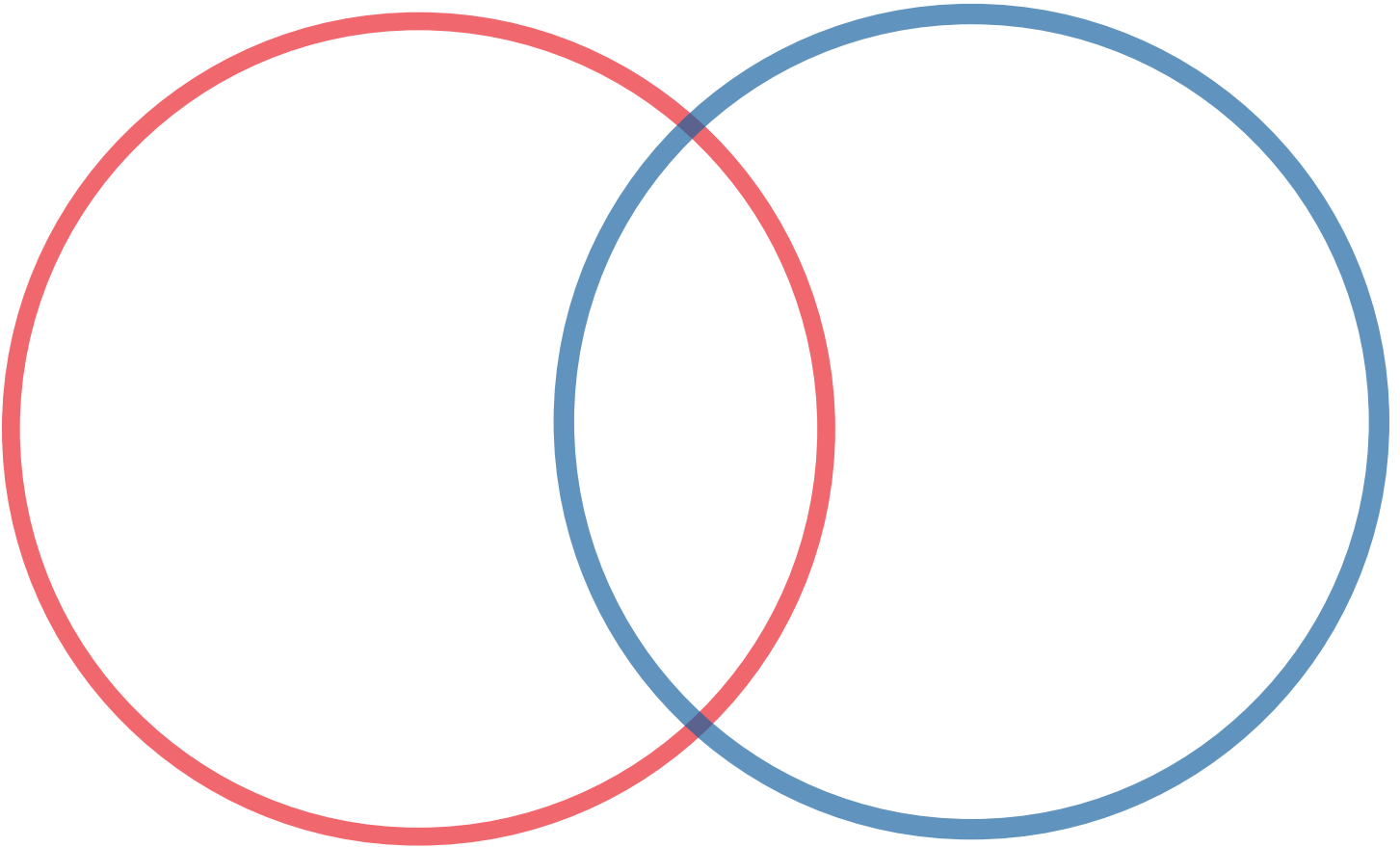

2. What are some of your “challenges” as a reader?

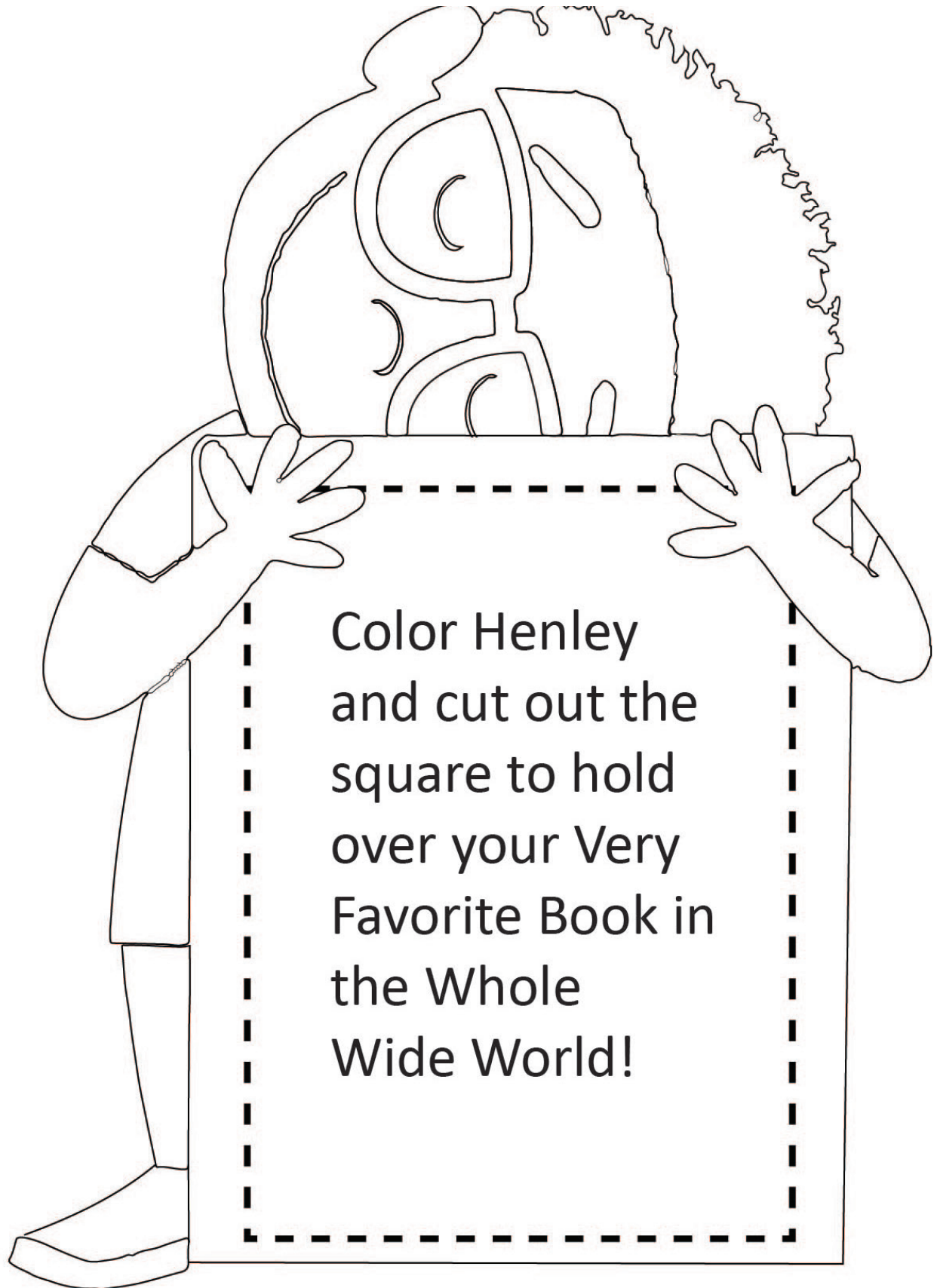
3. Do you prefer picture books or “giant” chapter books or a book that is a combination? Why?

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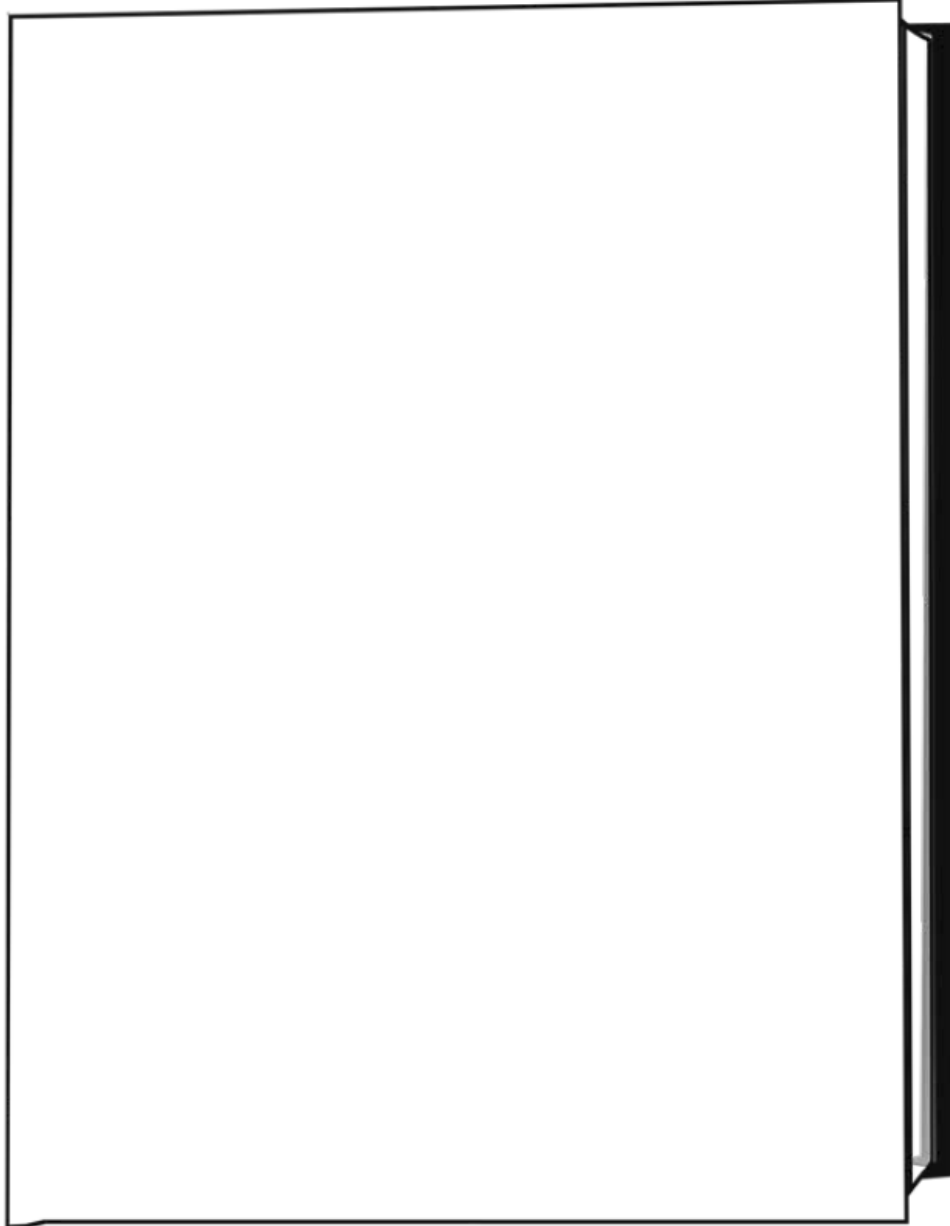
